MISSIONS

Under the supervision of the Preclinical Lead, the Senior Preclinical Project manager will be expected to drive coordination of regulatory preclinical development studies as well as transition from drug discovery to POC studies, and to do so to interact with multiple actors from preclinical to clinical and regulatory teams.

His/her responsibilities:

- Define strategies, together with team leaders, for the early preclinical development of new assets
- Manage the transition from drug discovery to preclinical development, and from preclinical development to translational proof of concept studies
- Ensure the effective selection of new drug candidates and define back up strategies together with drug discovery and early preclinical teams
- Manage internal preclinical trials
- Manage the selection and outsourcing of preclinical studies to CROs
- Manage development issues through close interaction with different groups (Clinical development, QA & Regulatory, etc.)
- Review and validate the studies documentation, analysis, and discussion about results with team leaders and CROs
- Write/update the preclinical part of the regulatory documents (IND, IB, IMPD)
- Closely interact with program management
- Write SOPs
